

Please observe the following notes on changing images for ILUMAG flex

- The number of image changes and the quality of the image surface depend largely on the cleanliness of the adhesive surface.
- Smaller image formats can also be changed on the wall if necessary (see video)
- Otherwise, to change the image, place the system on a smooth surface.
- Lift the previous backlit film with a pointed object at one corner, grasp it and slowly pull the film off the surface.
- Then store the backlit film clean and smooth, or rolled in a large sheet. If the backlit film is warped or bent (e.g. due to storage), it can no longer be used. In the case of uniform curvature due to rolling, the film can be rolled in the opposite direction to the original direction and used after sufficient time, i.e. if it is flat enough.
- Place the new, well-cleaned backlit film on one edge of the system and spread it evenly (without tension) onto the adhesive surface using a flat object (e.g. a plastic squeegee). Using a fabric wrapper with the squeegee can prevent scratch marks.
- If the adhesive surface of the system does not adhere adequately even when the backlit film is in good condition, it is usually due to adhering dirt (e.g. fibers or dust) or light grease (e.g. from contact with skin). In this case, the surface can be wiped evenly with clean alcohol (e.g. methylated spirits) using a lint-free cloth (e.g. cleanroom non-woven fabric).
- In the case of large-format backlit films, it is recommended (after thorough cleaning) to place a translucent, clean auxiliary film (at least the size of the system) 5 to 10 cm from one edge on the adhesive surface. The backlit film is again placed on this auxiliary film and moved until it is in the optimum position relative to the system. It is then pressed down in this position while holding the open adhesive edge and while the auxiliary film is gradually pulled out from under the backlit film (e.g. with a plastic or felt squeegee) evenly spread.
- If the backlit film does not run correctly or ultimately lies, repeat the process until successful.
